All students in the school are required to wear school uniform. It is a standard expected by the staff and Governing Body being a tradition of The Malling School that uniform is worn. Uniform encourages a sense of belonging to and pride for the school.

Parents, in general, have indicated that they welcome a uniform which reflects that the school has a caring attitude about standards and its own identity.

Students are encouraged to take a pride in their appearance and in wearing a uniform; this also aids identification by members of the public and is helpful when school parties visit other locations. The Malling School students are expected to behave well in public and be proud to be seen as a student from this school.

Wearing a uniform is socially acceptable for all students and eliminates the competitiveness in wearing fashion clothes.

The Sixth Form are allowed to wear clothing of their own choice provided that it is smart and business-like. Jeans are not acceptable.

No jewellery may be worn except a wristwatch, one pair of ear studs and a signet ring.

BASEBALL CAPS ARE NOT TO BE WORN WITH SCHOOL UNIFORM AT ANY TIME AND HOODED TOPS ARE NOT ALLOWED.

Girls

The Malling School navy blazer, badged. White Blouse, long or short sleeved button-through, to be worn with a tie. Pale blue V-neck sweater (optional) available from the school. The Malling School tie, navy blue skirt, smart black trousers, black shoes (suitable for school)

Girls PE

Navy blue PE shorts or games skirt (pleated), white T –shirt with school logo, white P.E. socks, white Trainers (NOT trainer boots), Navy blue tracksuit/jogging bottoms (optional), shin pads (compulsory for Hockey), Navy blue sweatshirt (optional).

Boys

The Malling School navy blazer, badged. Black /Dark grey trousers, white shirt long or short sleeves, The Malling School tie. Pale Blue V-neck sweater (optional) - available from school. Black shoes.

Boys PE

The Malling School Reversible Rugby Shirt, Navy Rugby/ P.E. Shorts, school rugby socks, white T-shirt with school logo, white P.E. socks, white trainers (NOT trainer boots). Football boots and shin pads (compulsory). Navy blue Tracksuit/jogging bottoms (optional).

All Pupils

A waterproof training jacket with the school logo is available from the PE department priced £22.50.

For Science a protective garment is necessary for laboratory use and for Technology and Art, a white calico apron or other protective garment is essential. Hair should be restrained for practical activities. Jewellery and other valuable items should never be brought to school. Students with pierced ears may wear a plain gold or silver stud in each ear. Other forms of body piercing are not allowed. Pupils are allowed to wear one ring providing it is not of the heavy variety which could cause injury. The school accepts no responsibility or liability for the damage to, or loss of, items of jewellery or personal possessions.

All items of clothing and equipment should be clearly named.
