## **Revise with Us**

To continue to support the students in their final run up to the exams, we would like to invite you to "**Revise with Us**" on Wednesday 1st May, 4.30-5.30 pm. The aim of this session is to empower you to support your child with their revision at home.

During the session, along with your child, you will experience three

different revision strategies that can be used for revising any subject. Each strategy will be modelled by one of our Senior Leadership Team using English, Science and Maths examples. During each of these sessions you will see what to do and have an opportunity to practise alongside your child.
