Dear Parents/Carers of Year 11 students

Yesterday we welcomed back our Year 11 students for their last week and a half of important lessons. The majority of our Year 11 students attended a start of Term 6 assembly this morning where they were spoken to by myself, Mrs Hanmore, Dr Shirley, Mrs Allison and Mrs Thompson. Our Year 11 students are now officially over half-way through their GCSE exams. As a year group, they have sat 21 exams and have 19 left to take.

In order to best support our Year 11 students and your children in the remaining time they have left we wanted you to know the message we gave them yesterday.

- Our Year 11 students' behaviour entering and during EVERY exam has been exceptional.
- Even after morning exams, they have maintained their focus in afternoon lessons and continue to work hard.
- The majority are continuing to attend P6 interventions and revising regularly at home.
- They are brilliant role models to our younger students.

**We did stress that their remaining lessons this week and next week (until the 15<sup>th</sup> June) are vitally important.** These lessons have been carefully planned by their teachers and have been tailored specifically to their exams. We expect all our Year 11 students to attend these lessons and any absence that has not been officially agreed by school will unfortunately be classed as an unauthorised absence. We really value your efforts in ensuring our students attend school every day.

Key dates for our Year 11 students are:

1. Last day of formal lessons is 15<sup>th</sup> June. Students then only attend school for their remaining exams (in full school uniform)
2. Year 11 BBQ and Leavers' Assembly is on 15<sup>th</sup> June
3. Last GCSE exam is on 23<sup>rd</sup> June
4. Year 11 Prom is on 8<sup>th</sup> July
