One of the daily expectations of all students at The Malling School is to have the correct equipment every lesson, every day. This is essential if a student is to arrive to their lessons ready to learn and be the best they can be every lesson, every day.

All students at The Malling School are required to have the equipment listed below for lessons. This equipment needs to be carried in a school bag that is sufficiently big enough to hold it all.

We will be carrying out equipment checks with every student next week during Period One and will be reminding them of the importance of having the correct equipment every day in their year group assemblies. We are happy to give the essential equipment to students but will welcome your support in ensuring that your child comes to school every day with the required equipment in order for them to successfully participate in all lessons. Should there be a persistent problem, students should expect to be placed in a lunchtime or after-school reflection.

Required equipment every day:

- Knowledge Organiser/curriculum booklet (preferably in a plastic wallet)
- Pens (Blue or Black AND Green)
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Eraser
- Sharpener
- Appropriate books
- Calculator (for mathematics and science)
- Mini-white board and pen
- Highlighters

Required equipment on certain days (according to timetable):

- PE kit
- Cooking ingredients (for food technology)

Could I also remind parents and carers that shoes must be worn as part of our uniform. Under exceptional circumstances, trainers are allowed, but this is only for an authorised medical reason. If a student does arrive to school wearing trainers, then we will provide students with shoes for the day. Should there be a persistent problem, students should expect to be placed in a lunchtime or after-school reflection.
