

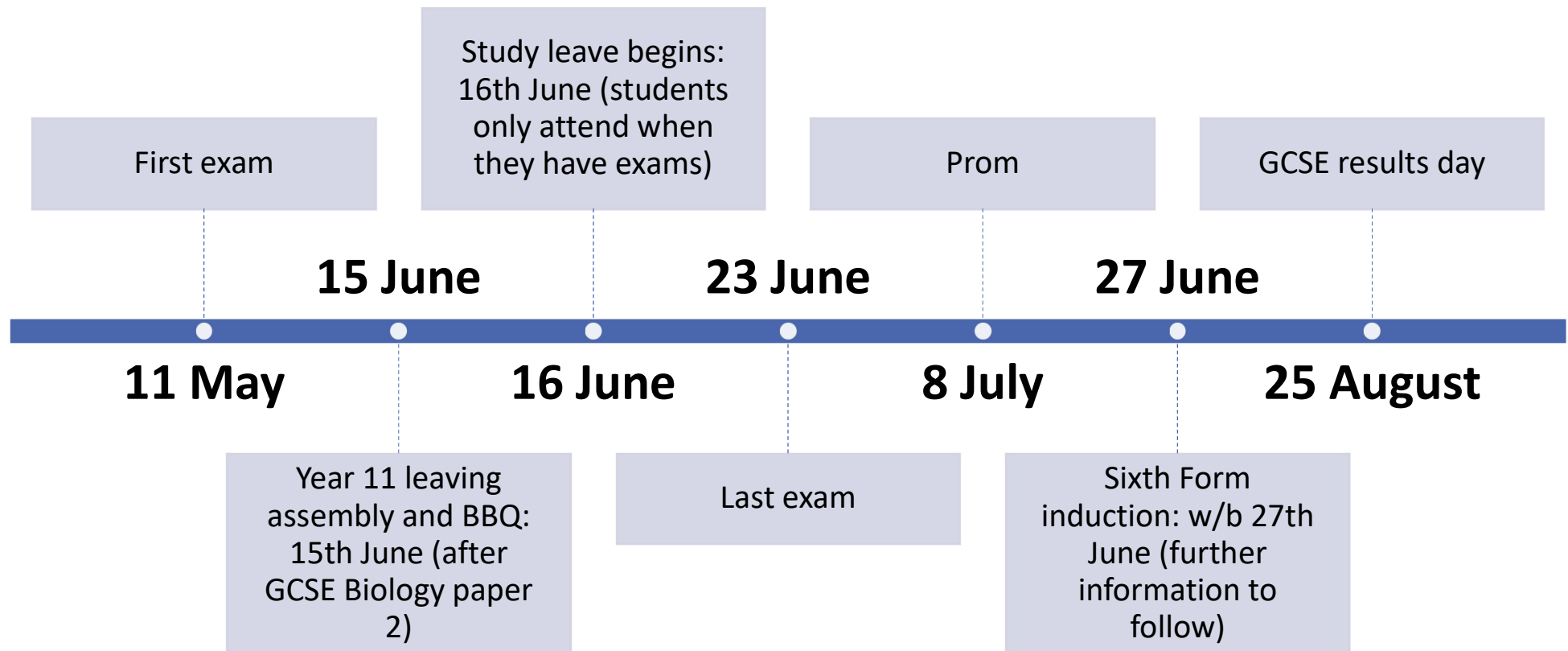

Exam Regulations



No speaking or communicating in any way inside the exam room, except with an invigilator

How Students can prepare



Attendance and punctuality



Focus in all lessons

How Students can prepare



Set an objective to your revision session

Decide what you need to know by the end of the session

Short, focused and regular



Test what you already know

Do this by writing it down, it will help you to be even more specific on what you are working on



Work on what you don't know

Flash cards – incredibly useful but make sure you are not over filling each card with too much information

Mind maps

Revision guides

Read, cover, write, check, repeat

Work sheets



Check knowledge against your objective

Re – test yourself



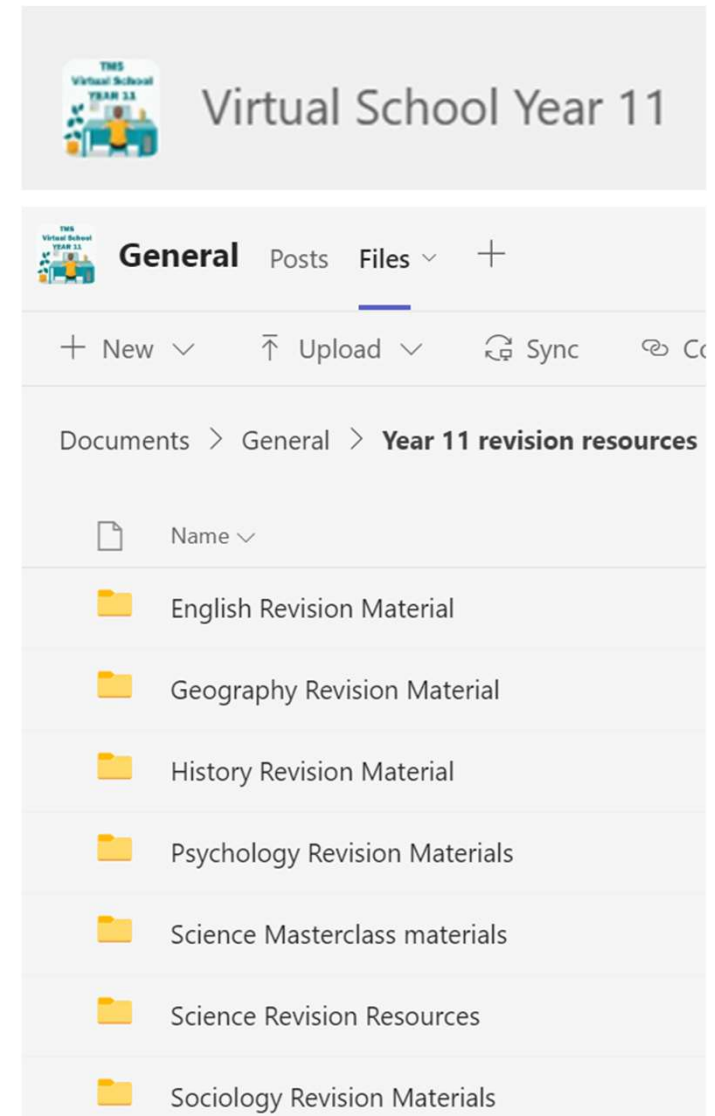
Interleave what you are working on

Mix different parts of the topic and knowledge into different revision session

Return to the topics again and again leaving longer gaps

Core Subject Guidance: English

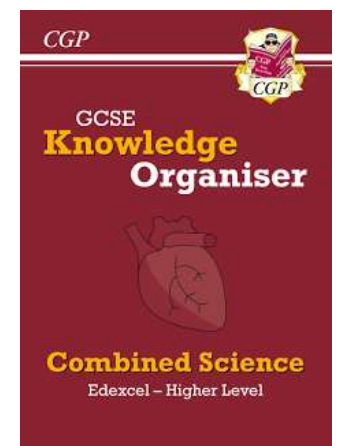
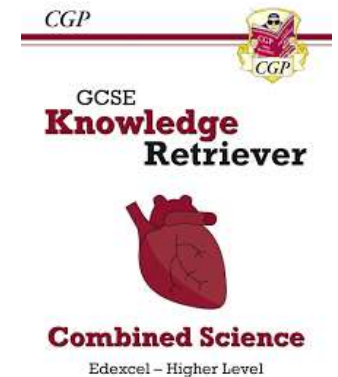
- Bespoke lessons are now being delivered to meet the needs of each individual class.
- Homework continues to be set weekly and these tasks will help to guide students with their revision.
- The most effective revision strategy for English is timed responses and plans. There are a wealth of papers available on the virtual school or outside R18 for students to access.
- P6 intervention continues to run each Tuesday in R18.

Core Subject Guidance: Maths

- All pupils have been given a list of topics which are planned to be tested in the GCSEs with links to Hegarty and Corbettmaths.
- All pupils have a detailed gap analysis from their February mock exams which has the links to Hegarty which they should use to help prioritise their revision.
- Homework is bespoke to each class with the teacher determining what the pupils should be doing.
 - Eg their chosen topics on Hegarty informed by their GA plus a predicted paper to be completed and handed in for marking.
- Every lesson is bespoke to the class whilst following the same order of delivery regarding paper 1, 2 and 3 content in order to meet the needs of each pupil.
- P6 runs every Thursday for revision on key concepts

Core Subject Guidance: Science

- A programme of revision lessons is being delivered to Yr11
- All students have received a knowledge organiser (red book) and retrieval booklet (white book).
 - Those studying separate sciences have one for each science.
- Homework is:
 - Tassomai (minimum 4 daily goals per week)
 - Retrieval practice using KO booklet (directed by class teacher)
- Topics to prioritise for revision have been shared with students and uploaded to Teams.
- Past papers and mark schemes are available on Teams for students to complete for their planned practice.
