Dear Parents/Carers

I am writing to inform you of our current PE kit policy in place at The Malling School. Students have all been reminded of the expectations of the PE department with regards to bringing their PE kit. I have summarised these expectations below:

- Students should bring their PE kit for all PE lessons as this is part of the required school equipment list.
- If a student is ill or injured they should provide their teacher with a signed letter validating this. (They will still need their PE kit for this lesson.)
- If students fail to bring their Malling School PE kit on 3 occasions they will receive an afterschool reflection.

It is vital that students still bring their PE kit even when not able to be involved practically, this is to ensure that they do not miss out on the key content being delivered within these lessons. We cannot always guarantee that ill/injured students will be able to stay inside during their PE lessons, therefore PE kit will be required to face the unpredictable weather conditions which they will face throughout the year. This will ensure school uniform is kept clean and dry for the remainder of the day.
