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












We're excited to inform you about a big improvement in how we manage information and communicate with you at school. We are changing our system to Bromcom, a trusted provider known for its innovative solutions in education technology. This change means we will no longer be using our current system, SIMS, by the end of March 2024, and it's app will be replaced by the My Child at School (MCAS) app starting Monday, April 15th, 2024.

What is MCAS?

MCAS is a user-friendly app and web portal designed to give you real-time access to important information about your child's school life. You can see their timetable, attendance, achievements, behaviour, homework, exam details, and reports. It's a convenient way to stay updated and connected with what's happening at school.

Key features of MCAS include:

- **Real-time Academic Updates**: Instant access to your child's weekly timetable, term dates, and academic milestones.
- **Streamlined Communication**: Effortlessly communicate with the school. Changed address or phone number? You can update us through the portal.
- Attendance Tracking: Monitor your child's attendance records for the year-to-date, along with subject-specific attendance metrics.
- Achievement and Behaviour Monitoring: Stay informed about your child's achievements, behaviour logs, and issued detentions.
- **Exam Information**: Access student exam timetables and pertinent exam-related details.
- Homework Management: Keep track of assigned homework tasks for your child(ren).
- **Report Viewing**: Conveniently view and access school reports directly through the app.

We will be working over the Easter holidays to make sure the app is ready for you when the new term starts. Instructions on how to register for the app will be sent to you directly from Bromcom during the week commencing April 1st, 2024.
