Below are the key details regarding our end-of-year arrangements, including Celebration Day and the revised timetable after the May half-term.

Celebration Day – Monday 15th June

On Monday 15th June, we will be holding a Celebration Day to recognise the hard work and achievements of our Year 11 students. The schedule for the day is as follows:

Revised Timetable – After May Half-Term

Following the May half-term, students will follow a revised timetable to support their preparation for the remaining exams.

- For subjects with exams after half-term, a programme of carefully planned masterclasses will be in place, tailored to each subject.
- The day will be split into two sessions: one before break and one after break.
- Students will be allowed to leave the school site at lunchtime (12:10pm).
- A supervised study room will be available for students who wish to remain on site or who require transport (bus/taxi) to get home.
- Each student will receive a personalised timetable outlining the compulsory sessions they must attend. As with their current timetable, students will be registered, and parents/carers will be notified if a student misses a scheduled session.
