Update for Friday 26th June – Hot Weather Arrangements

I would like to begin by thanking our students and staff for the resilience, kindness and support they have shown one another during this week's exceptionally hot weather. We have been incredibly proud of how our school community has pulled together and adapted so positively to the challenging conditions.

Student wellbeing remains our priority, and we continue to make every effort to keep everyone as comfortable as possible. Throughout the school day, students have regular opportunities to refill their water bottles, and we are re-rooming classes wherever possible to make use of our cooler teaching spaces.

Please note the following arrangements for **Friday 26th June**:

Uniform

As previously communicated, students may continue to wear their official TMS PE kit for the day. Alternatively, students may choose to wear their normal school uniform with the usual summer adjustments in place; blazers and ties are not required.

Additional Break

This Friday 26th June, we will introduce an additional break between Periods 4 and 5, from **2.05pm to 2.20pm**. This will give students and staff time to refill water bottles, visit the toilets and take a short pause before the final lesson of the day. Please ensure that your child brings a filled water bottle to school each day. We will also have additional water and cups available to support anyone who needs them. We hope that this extra break, together with the shortened Period 5, will help everyone feel more comfortable.

Year 10 Mock Examinations

The Year 10 French and Spanish writing mock examinations scheduled for Friday afternoon will be postponed. Students will instead attend their normal timetable lessons. The examinations will be completed over the next fortnight during their normal Modern Foreign Languages lessons, and appropriate adaptations will be made for students with access arrangements.


