Uniform Arrangements for Hot Weather

Following a review of the weather forecast, we are making some temporary adjustments to our uniform expectations to ensure students remain comfortable and safe during the warmer weather.

Monday 22nd June – Wednesday 24th June: Official TMS PE kit permitted.

Thursday 25th June – Friday 26th June: Return to school uniform with summer adjustments in place (tie and blazer optional).

Due to the high temperatures forecast for Monday 22nd June – Wednesday 24th June, students may wear their official TMS PE kit on these days.

- Only official TMS PE kit items are permitted.
- No alternative sportswear or non-uniform items should be worn.

Students who do not wish to wear PE kit may attend in full school uniform. During this period, ties and blazers will be optional to help students remain comfortable in the warmer weather.

On Thursday 25th and Friday 26th June the weather is forecast to be cooler, and students will return to school uniform. As a summer adjustment, students should wear full school uniform, including school shoes, with ties and blazers remaining optional. This also provides families with an opportunity to wash and prepare PE kit following the warmer days earlier in the week.


Students should also bring a filled water bottle.
