Dear Parent/Carer,

To make the student login process simpler and more reliable, we have introduced Single Sign-On (SSO) for student access to Bromcom. This means students can now access the Bromcom Student Portal more easily to view their homework, timetable, attendance and other important school information.

How students log in

When in school using a school device:

- Visit www.bromcomvle.com
- Click "Login with Microsoft Account"
- Students will be logged in automatically with no further action required

When at home or using a non-school device:

- Visit www.bromcomvle.com
- Click "Login with Microsoft Account"
- Enter the student's school email address and school password
- The system will then sign them in automatically


What this means for students

With this improvement, students only need to remember one password to access all key school systems, including:

- Office 365
- Microsoft Teams
- Outlook (email)
- Bromcom Student Portal
- Sparx Maths
- Sparx Science
- and other school learning resources


