On Thursday 20th November, representatives from Maidstone and Tunbridge Wells NHS Trust will be visiting our school to deliver a presentation to our Year 12 and Year 13 female students.

The session will focus on gynecological cancer, a serious health issue that can affect women of all ages. The presentation aims to increase awareness and understanding by covering:
