Dear Parents/Carers,

You will soon receive a letter from the KentChoices team explaining more about how you can use their site to make applications for your child's future.

You do not need to create log in details yourself. We have done this for you and your child will be supported to log in for the first time on either the 27th or 28th of October. You can start exploring and researching options by attending open events and using the KentChoices site now without having to log in.

Once your child has been given their log in details and have completed their research, they can log in, complete their personal profile, and make applications to their chosen onward pathway. They can apply to more than one institution and get as many offers as they like, then decide on results day which option they would like to accept. It is wise to apply for more than one place, in case your child changes their mind or does not meet the entry criteria for a certain course.

If your child is keen to go to college to do any trade course, they need to apply before the Christmas break to secure an interview and avoid disappointment. Trade courses are very popular and fill up fast. The aim is for all year 11's to have made at least one application

If your child is interested in apprenticeships, I will be working with them more in the spring term. Anyone who wants an apprenticeship must have applied to college and/or 6th form as a back-up plan because apprenticeships are difficult to secure and can fall through.
