Dear Parent/Carer,

As we move towards the spring and summer terms and the warmer weather that comes with them, we would like to take this opportunity to send a gentle reminder about our Sixth Form dress code.

We fully appreciate that lighter clothing becomes more comfortable at this time of year however, Sixth Form students are expected to dress in a way that reflects a smart, professional working environment. As senior members of the school community, they play an important role in setting the standard and modelling expectations for our lower year groups.

Our expectation remains that students attend school in attire that is:

- Smart and professional
- Appropriate for a mixed-age school environment
- Clean and in good condition

Clothing such as ripped or faded items, shorts, very short skirts, low-cut or sheer tops, hoodies, tracksuits, and casual footwear (including trainers and flip-flops) are not permitted. Subject-specific clothing (e.g. for Sport, Performing Arts or Art) should not be worn around the school site and students should change before moving into communal areas.

We are very proud of how our Sixth Form students represent both themselves and the school, and we thank you for your continued support in ensuring they maintain these high standards as the weather becomes warmer.
