Dear Parents/Carers

We are pleased to inform you that Year 7 students will be taking part in an exciting Outdoor Learning Day this term. The dates for each group are:

- **B side of timetable – Tuesday 23rd June**
- **A side of timetable – Tuesday 30th June**

The day will provide students with the opportunity to develop teamwork, resilience and problem-solving skills through a range of outdoor activities. Activities will include **orienteering, kayaking, tent building**, and a variety of other outdoor challenges.

To ensure students are comfortable and prepared for the day, they should arrive at school wearing their **full Malling School PE kit** and be appropriately dressed for outdoor activities.

Students should also bring:

- A filled water bottle
- Sun cream (applied before arriving and brought for reapplication if required)
- A hat or cap
- A thin waterproof jacket in case of occasional showers
- A change of spare clothes *
- A towel *

*We do not plan to get wet, however students may get wet during the kayaking activities, so the spare clothes and towel will help ensure they remain comfortable for the rest of the school day.

The structure of the school day will remain the same and students will have access to the canteen at break and lunchtime as usual.
