Dear Parent/Carer,

We are pleased to share a positive update regarding arrangements for our Year 12 students as part of our ongoing commitment to supporting their independence and readiness for post-16 study. Following careful consideration, we would like to inform you that Year 12 students may be permitted to leave school early on Fridays at 2:05 pm, provided they do not have a scheduled lesson during Period 5.

This arrangement is offered as a privilege and is subject to ongoing review. Please note that there is no guarantee that this provision will continue into the next academic year from September, as their timetable may not allow for this to happen. At this stage, we will be monitoring this arrangement very closely.

Eligibility for this early departure is limited to students who demonstrate good attendance and whose absences are appropriately justified. Unfortunately, this arrangement will not apply to all Year 12 students.

Students who choose to leave early must sign out using the designated register provided by the school. This is essential to ensure accurate safeguarding records are maintained.

Students who do not have a Period 5 lesson but prefer to remain in school are, of course, welcome to do so. They may use the Hub to complete independent study. Please be aware that any student who leaves the site during Period 5 despite having a scheduled lesson will be recorded as truant, and appropriate sanctions will be applied.

On Friday Week A, the following lesson is scheduled meaning that students are required on site:

- History
- Geography
- Sports
- English
- Psychology
- Performing Art
- Art & Design
- Media Studies
