

## **LEVEL 2 ASDAN**

### **Employability (vocational pathway)**



#### **Introduction:**

This course is designed to help students to develop the essential skills that are required for the world of work.

These skills include job searching, digital skills, interview techniques, assessing risk and working with others.

This qualification aims to improve the student's confidence and communication skills in order to support them on their onward pathways.

#### **Course structure:**

The course is assessed via evidence presented in a portfolio.

Mandatory Units:

Module 1 – Career Exploration

Module 2 – Apply for a job

Module 3 Health and Safety in the workplace.

#### **Careers:**

All the units studied include the knowledge and transferable skills required across the job market.

#### **Assessment:**

Assessment is by portfolio of evidence, which is internally moderated prior to being externally moderated.

Level 2 Award – achievement of 3 mandatory units ( 6 credits).

Level 2 Certificate – achievement of 3 mandatory units plus optional units up to a total of 9 credits (making a total of 15 credits).

#### **Entry requirements:**
